

The Langlade County Fairgrounds Advisory Committee invites race fans and racing event organizers to attend a meeting on **Thursday, August 23, 2012 at 3:30 p.m. at the Forestry Office located at the Fairgrounds.** The purpose of the meeting is to discuss the status of racetrack components that are currently the property of the Antigo Stock Car Association, including: guard rails and posts, cement barriers, weigh scale, racetrack light fixtures, wheel fence and pipe. The parties are in the process of negotiating the worth of these racetrack components based upon a range of valuations set forth in recent appraisals.

Since 1994, the County has leased the Fairgrounds for stock car racing on Friday nights; however this lease ended in June, 2012. The Committee is interested to hear from race fans and racing event organizers regarding future uses of the racetrack, and specifically to discover whether any individual or organization may be interested in leasing the Fairgrounds racetrack and/or assisting the County in its pursuit to acquire ownership of these racetrack components.
