3. At 7:30 a.m. – Public Hearing to solicit public input regarding the amendment of County Ordinance Section 7.13 (5)(c) Traffic Code, to consider extending the existing ATV route on CTH “B” from CTH “T” to Merlin Street, approximately 320’ to Forest Road.
4. At approximately 7:45 a.m., close Public Hearing and review public input to determine if County Ordinance Section 7.13 (5)(c) Traffic Code should be recommended for extension of the existing ATV route on CTH “B” , approximately 320’ , from CTH “T” to Forest Road.
5. Approve the agenda.
6. Approve the minutes of the previous two meetings.
7. Public comment on agenda items and consideration of requests for items to be added to future meeting agendas.
8. Discuss machinery, shop and repairs.
9. Discuss Highway operations.
10. Discuss public records request.
11. Review ATV speed limits on existing routes.
12. At approximately 8:15 a.m., move into closed session pursuant to WI. Statute 19.85(1)(c), to consider employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility; to complete the Highway Commissioner’s one year performance evaluation.
13. At approximately 8:30 a.m., return to open session with possible action on any matter discussed during closed session.
14. Adjourn meeting.
