Consider Resolution regarding request from Don Bintz, owner of Unmanned Systems Incorporated (USI), supporting the UAV testing and training at the Langlade County Airport. Don Bintz, addressed the Committees asking for support for Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAV) testing and training at the Langlade County Airport. Don stated that FAA has given authorization and presented an overview on what the UAV capabilities and uses are. Don said that the UAV's are capable for mapping cartography and 3D modeling, construction and surveying and thermal surveying and inspecting. One of the goals for Unmanned Systems Incorporated is to work with some of the local farms. The biggest concern from the public is a breach of privacy. Don stated that there is a law stating that you cannot use military equipment for surveillance on civilians. UAV operation will comply with all applicable legal requirements at all times, including but not limited to FAA Regulatory requirements. Don gave the Committees a demonstration on the UAV.
