It was moved by Klimoski, seconded by Novak, to convene into open session at 10:10 a.m. Roll call vote: Klimoski – aye, Scupien – aye, Novak – aye, Hardin – aye, and Nye – aye. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Klimoski, seconded by Scupien to award the bids to the apparent high bidders on all of the fall timber sale jobs contingent on all bid values being correct, the advertised minimum bid for each specie being met, and all specifications and reference checks are met. All ayes. Motion carried.

There were 28 of 28 sales sold. A total of 135 bids were received from 18 bidders. The grand total of the winning bids was \$1,115,082.04.

4. Pledge of Allegiance – The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
5. Public Comment on Agenda Items and Consideration of Requests for Items to be Added to Future Meeting Agendas – Sam Hardin requested that Rantala investigate the possibility of Christmas tree cutting permits on the county forest.
6. Minutes – A motion was made by Klimoski, seconded by Scupien, to approve the minutes of the October 22, 2015 meeting. All ayes. Motion carried.
7. Discuss Knights Templar Request to Purchase County Land – Don Schoonenberg of the Knights Templar addressed the committee regarding the purchase of county land in Section 9; T33N-R10E (Township of West Upham). The county land in Section 9 is inaccessible to the county from county lands because of the wetlands from the east. The county has had to access the property from Knights Templar property in the past. The land in question is approximately 30 acres and has ash trees over maple seedlings. Logging is very restricted on the Knights Templar property due to high seasonal use by their members. Rantala informed the committee that Chapter 400 of the Langlade County Forest Comprehensive Land Use Plan states that lands within the County Forest boundary will not normally be considered for withdrawal and sale. To withdraw lands from County Forest, County Board and DNR must determine that the land will be put to better and higher use. Motion by Klimoski, seconded by Novak to table for further discussion and investigation and discuss at a future meeting with a Knights Templar representative. All ayes. Motion carried
8. Discuss/Review Augustyn to Summit Lake ATV Trail Proposal – Pete Resch and Rus Cook of the Parrish Highlanders ATV club addressed the committee regarding their request for an ATV trail route from Augustyn to Summit Lake. There is a current route that is used, but it takes much longer to get there. The route that they are proposing is shorter and would make a complete loop, but would require both Town and County road routes along with logging roads on County Forest and private property to be utilized. With this proposal, approximately 60% of the trail would be on the Ice Age Trail. Joe Jopek stated that in 1988 the Ice Age Trail had to be rerouted for the Augustyn Springs ATV trail. With the current option suggested, 4 miles of the Ice Age Trail would be affected, which is 1/10th of the Ice Age Trail System. If the new trail/route would follow

Hwy. J to Pence Lake Road and use the right-of-way for Hwy. A, the Ice Age Trail would not need to be used. Rantala is looking at options that utilize existing roads that are currently open to motorized traffic. There are two ways that this project could be funded and maintained under the ATV program. If this project is applied for as a “trail”, development and yearly maintenance funds would be available. If this was funded as a “Troute”, only yearly maintenance funds would be available. Rantala has some concerns about development costs if applied for as a “Troute”, as there is approximately 7 miles to develop. As a troute, other motorized uses could continue; as a trail, ATV’s/UTV’s would only be able to utilize. The earliest this project could be applied for is the April 15th grant deadline, with a decision on funding in August by the ORV Council. Additional permits will need to be applied for as well. Motion by Klimoski, seconded by Hardin to hold a joint meeting with the Highway and Forestry Committees to discuss ATV issues on Monday, December 21 at 9 a.m. All ayes. Motion carried.

9. Review Proposals for 2016 4x4 Utility Vehicle with Tracks – Proposals were received for a 2016 4x4 utility vehicle with tracks to groom the cross country ski trails at Jack Lake and Kettlebowl and to be used at Jack Lake during the summer. This project has funds of \$28,500 budgeted in the 2016 capital improvement plan. The proposals were as follows:

PowerPac, Inc., Marshfield - \$25,287.18
 Riesterer & Schnell, Antigo - \$27,705.00

Motion by Klimoski, seconded by Hardin to accept the low proposal of \$25,287.18 PowerPac, Inc., of Marshfield for a 2016 4x4 utility vehicle with tracks. All ayes. Motion carried.

10. Discuss Expired Timber Sale Contracts - Rantala reviewed with the committee a list of expired contracts, along with the staff recommendations for each.

Rantala explained the extensions stating that the first increase for an expired contract is 5 percent and then each increase after that is 10 percent. The Forestry Department staff has reviewed all contracts.

Motion by Klimoski, seconded by Hardin to accept the staff recommendations regarding the 2015 expired timber sales. All ayes. Motion carried.

11. Discuss/Approve Good Neighbor Authority Agreement - Rantala informed the committee that the DNR has received the Master Agreement (10 year agreement) from the federal government for the Good Neighbor Authority (GNA), which allows the DNR to assist with management on the National Forest using State policies and procedures, not Forest Service. Counties with County Forest are eligible to enter into an MOA with DNR to perform this work. Counties would be reimbursed for wages, mileage and overhead costs. Several members of the staff have shown an interest in working 4-10's and then on the 5th day, working on the forest service lands at 1½ time, which would be reimbursed 100% so there would be no cost to the county. Rantala stated that this would amount to no more than 100-200 hours per year to start, travel would be only 45-60 minutes away, and County work is the priority. Motion by Scupien, seconded by Klimoski to approve the Good Neighbor Authority Agreement and forward a resolution to county board for approval. All ayes. Motion carried.
12. Approve 2016 Langlade County Forest Work Plan - Rantala explained that the annual work plan functions as a planning guidance tool and further defines and supplements the county's fifteen-year comprehensive land use plan. This work plan also fulfills the DNR requirement to meet with Langlade County annually and evaluate whether both parties have met their partnership obligations. The plan covers timber harvest, reforestation,

forest protection, wildlife management, other forest uses, land purchases/sales/exchanges, recreation, time standards, forest certification, special projects, grants, funding and partners. Some changes to previous plans include planning for treatment of invasive species, a cut in wildlife management funding, and changes to forest certification regarding green tree retention. Having the Languade County Board of Supervisors approve the annual work plan is a requirement of eligibility to apply for the forest administrator grant, which reimburses Languade County for wages and fringe benefits of the forest administrator of over \$45,000 annually. Motion by Klimoski, seconded by Novak to approve the 2016 Languade County Work Plan and forward a resolution to county board for approval. All ayes. Motion carried.

13. Update Resolution for County Conservation Aid Program Grant - Rantala informed the committee that CCFA funds are State Aid for fish and game projects. In the past, we have used this grant for Languade County's beaver control program and some projects at the bow and gun range. Rantala stated that the DNR needs an annually updated resolution authorizing himself to apply for these grants and to file the proper paperwork. Rantala also stated that these are 50/50 grants, and the grant applied for is usually less than \$5,000. Motion by Novak, seconded by Nye to approve an updated resolution which authorizes Rantala to apply for CCFA grants for Languade County's beaver control program, etc., and to forward the resolution to the county board. All ayes. Motion carried.
14. Review Budget Summary - Rantala reviewed with the committee the budget summary report of the forestry department revenues and expenditures through November 30, 2015.
15. Review Paid Bills - The committee reviewed the paid Forestry and Recreation Department bills for November.
16. Set Next Meeting Date - The next meeting will be scheduled for Friday, January 8, 2016, at 8:30 a.m., in the forestry office conference room, Fairgrounds, Antigo.
17. At approximately 11:00 a.m., consider moving into closed session pursuant to §19.85 (1)(c), Wisconsin Statutes, considering employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the government body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility, annual performance evaluation – Motion by Klimoski, seconded by Scupien to go into closed session at 11:25 a.m. Roll call vote: Klimoski – aye, Hardin – aye, Scupien – aye, Novak – aye, and Nye – aye. Motion carried.
18. At approximately 11:15 a.m., return to open session with possible action on any matters discussed in closed session – Motion by Klimoski, seconded by Scupien to return to open session at 11:31 a.m. All ayes. Motion carried.

The forest administrator received a favorable performance review from the oversight committee.

19. Adjournment – Motion by Klimoski, seconded by Hardin to adjourn at 11:43 a.m. All ayes. Motion carried.
