Update on FPP/LWRM Plan:

Duane Haakenson gave an update on the FPP/LWRM Plan process. The CAC met last week. Fred Heider from the North Central Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission is working on a draft that will go to county board in November. There needs to be a 30 day review period for the plan. The next LCC meeting will be held September 23 at 3:15 p.m. to allow time for the 30 days before a public hearing is held in October.

Department Update:

Graupner assisted landowners with FPP. She attended a TIP meeting. Clean Sweep was held in August and the NCLWCA summer tour. She attended a CAC meeting and a Waterways meeting and reviewed FPP/LWRM materials and is helping plan a grazing training for later this fall.

Bills:

A DATCP meeting was held in Wausau on August 26 and a CAC meeting in Antigo on August 27. TMDL (total maximum daily load) will be held in Oshkosh on September 17. A county conservationist
