Review and approve Emergency Management State Communications Plan

Henricks presented the State Communications Plan. Each county is to provide the state with what they call a tactical interoperability communications plan which lists all the resources that you have available in your county. When this is all done it will be a good resource. This all goes into a database so if there is ever a need for mutual aid everybody will know what every other county has available (what radio's, what frequencies they operate on etc.). Henricks stated that one of the requirements of the plan is that the oversight committee for the entity that takes care of the communications in that county approves the plan.

Moved by Olsen, second by Dahms to approve the Emergency Management State Communications Plan. All ayes. **Motion Carried.**
