Sheriff Greening stated that there are currently two (2) vacancies in the jail. One was hired as a road deputy and the other one resigned. There was a male and female on the eligibility list, but both candidate failed background checks. Due to Act10 stripping away benefits Sheriff Greening feels the quality of applicants has gone down. The deadline for the current advertisement for corrections officers has ended and he is in the process of reviewing the test scores.

Request approval to increase the hourly wage of casual corrections officer positions

Sheriff Greening asked to increase the casual corrections officer current wage of \$10 to \$12 per hour as this may be an incentive to attract people to work in the jail as casual employees. There hasn't been an increase that Sheriff Greening can remember since he took office.

Moved by Schuh, second by Leaver to approve increasing the hourly wage for casual corrections officer from \$10 to \$12 per hour. All ayes. **Motion carried.**

Alert System, ModUCom/ShoreTel Interface, Everbridge Notification System, and WI-CAMS Credentialing System. Here is just a brief synopsis of some of the month's activities:

- Installed an update to the Computer Information System CAD, Jail and Records Management software.
- Conducted a post shooting hotwash with the Antigo School District personnel on identified strengths and weaknesses from the prom shooting incident.
- Made a live appearance on the local radio station on the mass notification system.
- Made a presentation to the 40 member administration and staff teams of Gardner Dam Boy Scout Camps on active shooter response and domestic violence safety before the camp went into session.
- Attended the NE Regional WEM training meeting on WI-CAMS.
- Investigated a Spill Report of 40 gal. of hydraulic fluid on Pratt Rd., Post Lake. Clean-up was done by the spilling party.
- Worked on the 2016 Langlade Co. Emergency Operation Plan Annexes.
- Began the Hazardous Materials Off-Site Plan work with Merit Gear, Amron, Waukesha Bearing and Walmart.
