February provided opportunities to work on the All Hazard Mitigation Plan and hazmat issues. There are now 9 facilities in Langlade Co. that require an extensive Off-Site Plan to be developed for the amount of hazardous materials stored. Here is a brief synopsis of some of the month's activities:

- Received \$16,330.49 grant award to fund the 2nd Half of FFY 2012 of Emergency Management's operating costs.
- Chaired the 16 county NEWCOM Board meeting.
- Continued work on the development of MABAS for the fire service in Langlade Co.
- Attended the WEM Regional meeting to create a cross-walk for Langlade County's Emergency Operations Plan.
- Attended the Langlade County Traffic Safety Committee which address several safety issues.
- Held a Public Hearing and Interest Group meeting on final input on the All Hazard Mitigation Plan.
- Conducted an exercise on the use of a mobile damage assessment application with WEM, NCWRPC, Oneida, Portage and Langlade Counties.
