Call meeting to order/Pledge of Allegiance

Chairperson Bonacci called a meeting of the Langlade County Public Safety Committee to order on the above date at 8:00 a.m., the Pledge of Allegiance immediately followed.

Approval of Minutes of the April 07, 2015 meeting

Coroner Report

Larry Shadick presented the Coroner Reports for March and April. The reports were placed on file in the County Clerk's office with the minutes.

Sheriff Greening informed the committee that old marked squad #5 went to the Juvenile office, the old marked #8 will be replacing the training vehicle and the old

unmarked squad will go to investigator 416. The old training vehicle and the 2008 Chev Impala will be sent to auction.

Moved by Cahak, second by Poltrock to approve the Car Report. All ayes. **Motion Carried.**

Sheriff/Jail Office/Nurse Report

Sheriff Greening presented the Jail Office report and Nurse Report. The report was placed on file in the County Clerk's office with the minutes.

Sheriff Greening informed the committee that recently there was a Jury Trial on a sex offender and fortunately he was convicted. Sheriff Greening made arrangements to immediately transfer him to DOC due his special needs. Sheriff Greening said that additional time and expenses would have been astronomical for us if he would have stayed in our facility.

Sheriff Greening also wanted to make the committee aware that he has received several complaints again regarding the State Patrol conducting traffic stops and searches recently. Sheriff Greening wanted to make it clear that this involved the City of Antigo Police Department and not the Sheriff's Office. Sheriff Greening stated that the Sheriff's Office doesn't have anything to do with it and that he will not let the State Patrol go out in the county because he doesn't agree with what they're doing.

Moved by Dahms, second by Poltrock to approve the Sheriff/Jail Office/Nurse Report. All ayes. **Motion Carried.**

Request to refill vacant full-time Corrections Officer position

Sheriff Greening informed the committee that he received a letter of retirement from Tom Hunter with his last day being the end of June and asked permission to refill this position. The money is already in the budget.

Moved by Dahms, second by Pennington to refill the vacant full-time Corrections Officer position. All ayes. **Motion Carried.**

Request to refill vacant Jail Administrator position

Sheriff Greening informed the committee that he received a letter of retirement from Diane Baker effective June 15, 2015 and asked permission to refill this position. The money is already in the budget. Sheriff Greening also stated that this will be a more extensive hiring process.

Moved by Dahms, second by Cahak to refill the vacant Jail Administrator position. All ayes. **Motion Carried.**

Review and rank Capital Improvement Program requests for the Sheriff's Office

Sheriff Greening presented two items for the committee to review. They were Patrol Vehicle Replacement and Communications Upgrade. Sheriff Greening stated that both of these items are necessary. The committee ranked the Communications Upgrade as number 1 (Urgent) with an average score of 6 and the Patrol Vehicle Replacement as number 2 (should do/necessary) with an average score of 4.8.

Moved by Pennington, second by Dahms that the Capital Improvements Program requests were reviewed and ranked for the Sheriff's Office. All ayes. **Motion Carried.**

April was a busy month as we transition into the warmer temperature and severe weather. April 13-17 was Tornado/Severe Weather Awareness Week and provided public awareness opportunities. Below is just a brief synopsis of the month's activities:

- Conducted a WISCOM RCALL 41 state-wide radio system test.
- Coordinated the Frontier 911 system cut-over to a new Introdo format.
- Appeared on the Breakfast Club radio program addressing the Tornado/Severe Weather Awareness Week activities and public information.
- Attended the NE Regional meeting and programmed 8 of the State's android tablets with the Damage Assessment applications.
- Conducted a tornado drill in conjunction with Awareness Week. This included the County VoIP Phone system, which showed some issues that are being addressed.
- Attended the Fire Chief's Association meeting.
- Attended the Wisconsin Counties Association training session on Emergency Management in St. Point.
- Attended a webinar with Land Records staff on FEMA's work on the Wolf River watershed and updating flood plain mapping.
- Attended the Langlade Co. EMS Association meeting with Langlade Hospital.
- Submitted \$17,209.53 reimbursement claim for FFY 2015 1st Half Expenses.
