**Review and discuss Outagamie County Resolution No. 160-2013-14 to Support an act relating to the development of a system of short-term sanctions for individuals who violate conditions of extended supervision, parole, probation, or a deferred prosecution agreement and granting rule-making authority**

## Emergency Management Report-May 2014

April was an interesting month. It started with a stressful notification from Verizon that within 5 days they were “decommissioning” the Summit Lake site, which is used for Fire and EMS services for the north half of the County. After clarification and considerable negotiations, Verizon gave at no cost, the structure at the tower site and for \$514.00 sold the generator system there. The weather pattern allowed for us to escape any damaging spring melt water issues. There were grant reimbursement requests and awards along with Disaster Declaration data sent to the State from the City of Antigo and Village of White Lake for the damages incurred to water utilities over the winter. Here is a brief synopsis of just some of the month’s activities:

- Completed the Fire EMS antenna move on the White Lake Tower.
- Submitted 1<sup>st</sup> Half FFY 2014 EMPG reimbursement funding request for \$16,942.41.
- Received \$9,266.00 Hazmat Equipment Grant award.
- Participated in an 8 county regional hazardous materials spill exercise.
- Conducted a meeting with the State Exercise Officer with local law enforcement, fire, public health, Antigo School and Langlade Hospital to establish 3 year training/exercising plan.
- Chaired the Langlade Co. Management Team meeting.
- Participated in the Tornado/Severe Weather Awareness Week campaign including media interviews and mock tornado watch/warnings. City sirens were activated and the Langlade Co. phone systems over ride systems were tested.
- UDSR submission for Antigo and White Lake water utility damage.
