Marty's Shell specified they will use synthetic oil. Synthetic oil is very expensive. It was decided to have this item brought back to the next committee meeting after Sheriff Greening checks with Langlade Ford to see if their bid also included synthetic oil.

Sheriff Greening informed the committee that there are currently outstanding checks from the inmate commissary account for a total of \$336.90. These checks are given to inmates at their time of release from the jail, they are all dated from January 01, 2012 to December 31, 2012.

## Emergency Management Report - Nov. 2014

October is always an interesting month. I close out one year's Plan of Work and apply for the next year's. The Hazmat Computer and Equipment grant reimbursement was also sent during the month. Funding continues to be stable now and in the near future. Ebola has also reared its ugly head in the United States and on a local level we have been in the planning stages for any potential cases. Below is just a brief synopsis of some of the month's activities:

- Assisted the City of Antigo with public education regarding other notification options after they made the decision to discontinue outdoor weather sirens. This is only a beginning. I have encouraged the City to be very aggressive in getting info out and providing the citizens options.
- Participated in 5 planning sessions on local ebola efforts with Langlade Hospital, Public Health and EMS personnel.
- Participated in training on Continuity of Government/Continuity of Operations to put plans into place for each County Department to continue operations should standard operations become interrupted. This is a goal of mine for the next year to work with each County Department in putting those plans together.
- Attended the mandatory required All Hands Conference in Oshkosh.
- Conducted a tabletop exercise with Antigo School District, Langlade Hospital, EMS, Law Enforcement, Langlade Public Health and Mallette Bus staff on a school shooting incident, with a focus on reunification and social media. Photos attached.
- Submitted reimbursement requests for \$31,933.46 representing eligible reimbursement costs for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Half of this fiscal year and the Hazmat Equipment costs.
