Emergency Management Report-Sept. 2014

August continued the cooler, wet weather pattern that has left some severe weather in the aftermath. The White Lake/Langlade area has continued to experience communications issues as a solution to the problem has been hard to come by. Northway and the engineers believe we have a plan, but it has a cost. I am also in the process of obtaining cost quotes for a new radio interface for Dispatch, not only from Motorola but from ModUcom. I've also included some photos from the storm damage of last Thursday. Here is a brief synopsis of some of the month's activities:

- Met with Antigo School, State Emergency Management, law enforcement, hospital and EMS personnel to finalize plans for the joint Oct. 17 exercise.
- Met with the Elcho School principal and worked on a revised school safety plan that included and extensive re-write incorporating new concepts.
- Chaired the 16 county NEWCOM meeting in Marathon County.
- Conducted a LEPC (Local Emergency Planning Committee) meeting. Joseph Novak was selected as Chairman.
- Attended the Langlade Co. Traffic Safety Commission meeting.
- Chaired the Management Team meeting.
- Attended the NE Regional WEM meeting addressing Incident Management Teams and the Regional IMT that exists.
