

**Town of Antigo
Town Board Meeting
April 13, 2016**

Chairperson Rick Parilek called the Monthly Board Meeting to order on April 13, 2016 at 7:30 p.m. at the Antigo Town Hall. Other Board members present were Supervisor Jon Petroskey, Supervisor Wayne Schroeder, Clerk Rosemary Servi and Treasurer Cindy Igl. Also present was resident John McCullough and Mike Hoffman from Rusch Engineering and Surveying.

The clerk read the minutes of the prior month's meeting. The minutes were approved with a motion by Wayne and second by Jon. Motion carried.

Mike Hoffman, from Rusch Engineering and Surveying, presented Queen of Peace Cemetery's platting revision of the fifth addition. They are eliminating planned mausoleum lots, creating more crematory lots and double lots and making block 39 into individual lots. Jon motioned to approve the Queen of Peace Cemetery platting revision. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.

Gene Matuszewski, Jr., town assessor, arrived and the Board of Review was set for Tuesday, June 14th from 7 p.m. – 9 p.m. Gene will hold the Open Book on Tuesday, June 7th from 11 a.m. - 1 p.m.

The fire department has requested the Board approve a Cascade system and fill station to be mounted in the van. Estimates were received from Stainless & Repair, Inc. for \$5,500 - \$6,500 plus the mount of \$275 - \$375 and from Pomasl Fire Equipment for Red Power with an estimate of \$4,300 plus \$1,000 to install. Rick motioned that the fire department go with the Pomasl Fire Equipment estimate of \$4,300 plus \$1,000 to install. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.

Rick motioned to appoint Sally Hull as the fire department executive secretary for the period 4/15/16 – 4/14/17. The rate of pay will increase to \$10 per hour and will continue with a maximum of 25 hours per month. Jon seconded. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Wayne to not approve Langlade County drafting a camping trailer regulation ordinance regulating the parking of camper trailers on vacant parcels. Jon seconded. Motion carried. A copy of the form with the board's decision will be mailed to the Langlade County Land Records & Regulations department.

Jon motioned to adopt the Wisconsin Department of Transportation Disaster Damage Aids Petition for the water damage done to Schroeder Road on March 16, 2016 with an estimated repair cost of \$3,200. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.

The treasurer's report showed a checking balance of \$5,801.41, savings balance of \$429,323.20 and tax account balance of \$175,354.90 for a total of \$610,479.51.

The North Central Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission's survey on the updating of Langlade County's Outdoor Recreation Plan was completed by the Board and will be sent to them.

The May Board Meeting will be held on Wednesday, May 11th at 7:30 p.m.

The June Board Meeting will be held on Wednesday, June 15th at 7:30 p.m.

All approved bills were paid.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:25 p.m.
