

**Town of Antigo  
Annual Town Meeting  
April 16, 2014**

The Annual Town Meeting was called to order on April 16, 2014 at 7:30 p.m. by Chairperson Rick Parilek. Nine town residents and two nonresidents were in attendance.

The clerk read the minutes of the prior year's meeting. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Pete Pennington and seconded by Cindy Igl. A show of hands vote was taken. There were eight in favor. No one opposed. Motion carried.

The Town's 2013 Annual Financial Report was reviewed. Bob Lynett motioned to accept the financial report as presented. Pete Pennington seconded. A show of hands vote was taken. There were eight in favor. No one opposed. Motion carried.

Rick stated that Daryl Rasmussen passed away last year and that the Board appointed Ron Pizl to fill the constable position for the rest of the term.

Dan Hafner gave the fire department report and stated that there were 45 fire calls last year and 48 EMS calls. The fire department is applying for a 95% grant for the purchase of turnout gear and air packs. The department will also be getting part of the Remington grant.

Jon Petroskey, Fire Chief for the City of Antigo, gave the ambulance report. They had 1940 calls in 2013, which was a decrease of 21 from 2012. The fire department now has personnel trained in critical care paramedic level for facility transfers. These special care transports generate good revenue from Medicare. The department will eventually have six people trained in TEMS (tactical EMS) which go in with a SWAT team to assist people in an emergency situation.

Rick introduced Pete Pennington as the newly elected County Board Supervisor for Ward 1. Pete stated that he has had one County Board Meeting so far and has been elected to the Highway Department Committee. He is looking forward to his term of office.

A motion to set next year's annual meeting on Wednesday, April 22, 2015 at 7:30 p.m. was made by Gene Matuszewski and seconded by Bob Lynett. A show of hands vote was taken. There were eight in favor. No one opposed. Motion carried.

Being no further business, a motion was made to adjourn by Gene Matuszewski at 7:50 p.m. Bob Lynett seconded. A show of hands vote was taken. There were eight in favor. No one opposed. Motion carried.
