

**Town of Antigo
Annual Town Meeting
April 18, 2013**

The Annual Town Meeting was called to order on April 18, 2013 at 7:30 p.m. by Chairperson Rick Parilek. Also present were Supervisor Wayne Schroeder, Clerk Rosemary Servi and resident Bob Lynett. Also present from the Town of Antigo Volunteer Fire Department was Fire Chief Dan Hafner and Jason Hintt.

The clerk read the minutes of the prior year's meeting. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Bob Lynett and seconded by Wayne Schroeder. A show of hands vote was taken. There were four in favor. No one opposed. Motion carried.

The Town's 2012 Annual Financial Report was reviewed. Bob Lynett motioned to accept the financial report as presented. Wayne Schroeder seconded. A show of hands vote was taken. There were four in favor. No one opposed. Motion carried.

Rick stated that Daryl Rasmussen was reelected as Constable but will not be accepting the position due to health reasons. The Board will need to appoint someone to fill the position.

Tim Rusch is submitting the City of Antigo's water shed study in the 8th Avenue Area to the DNR for their input on recommendations the Town could do to control water in that area.

Rick stated that the town should finish updating to the state's new road sign reflectivity standards this year.

Dan Hafner gave the fire department report and stated that there were 33 fire calls last year and 25 EMS calls. The fire department received a DNR Grant and is in the running for a Federal Grant. The fire department will be providing presence at eight stock car races this year and will be receiving \$500 each time.

A motion to set next year's annual meeting on Wednesday, April 16, 2014 at 7:30 p.m. was made by Bob Lynett and seconded by Wayne Schroeder. A show of hands vote was taken. There were four in favor. No one opposed. Motion carried.

Being no further business, a motion was made to adjourn by Bob Lynett at 7:50 p.m. Wayne Schroeder seconded. A show of hands vote was taken. There were four in favor. No one opposed. Motion carried.
