**Town of Antigo
Annual Town Meeting
April 20, 2016**

The Annual Town Meeting was called to order on April 20, 2016 at 7:30 p.m. by Chairperson Rick Parilek. Eight town residents and two nonresidents were in attendance.

The clerk read the minutes of the prior year's meeting. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Gene Matuszewski, Sr. and seconded by Mike Winski. A show of hands vote was taken. There were eight in favor. No one opposed. Motion carried.

Rick introduced the current board along with the town assessor, Gene Matuszewski, Jr. and County Supervisor, Pete Pennington.

Rick presented Gene Matuszewski, Sr. a plaque on behalf of the town in appreciation for over 48 years of service as town assessor.

The Town's 2015 Annual Financial Report was reviewed. Pete Pennington motioned to accept the financial report as presented. Cindy Igl seconded. A show of hands vote was taken. There were eight in favor. No one opposed. Motion carried.

Mike Winski gave the fire department report. The fire department's rating improved from Level 7 to Level 6 last year. In 2015, the department had 41 fire calls and 24 EMS calls. They currently have 27 firefighters.

Jon Petroskey, Fire Chief for the City of Antigo, gave the ambulance report. In 2015, the Town of Antigo had 38 calls, a decrease of 16 calls from 2014. Overall, the City of Antigo Fire Department had more ambulance calls than ever in 2015 – with a total of 2,009 calls.

A motion was made to set next year's annual meeting on Wednesday, April 19, 2017 at 7:30 p.m. was made by Cindy Igl and seconded by Pete Pennington. A show of hands vote was taken. There were eight in favor. No one opposed. Motion carried.

Being no further business, a motion was made to adjourn by Mike Winski at 7:58 p.m. Pete Pennington seconded. A show of hands vote was taken. There were eight in favor. No one opposed. Motion carried.
