

**Town of Antigo
Town Board Meeting
February 8, 2017**

Chairperson Rick Parilek called the Monthly Board Meeting to order on February 8, 2017 at 7:30 p.m. at the Antigo Town Hall. Other Board members present were Supervisor Jon Petroskey, Supervisor Wayne Schroeder, Clerk Rosemary Servi and Treasurer Cindy Igl. Also present was Town of Polar Chairperson Nathan Walrath and Surveyor Tim Rusch.

The clerk read the minutes of the prior month's meeting. The minutes were approved with a motion by Wayne and second by Jon. Motion carried.

Jon motioned to sign the fire equipment agreement received from the Town of Polar stating that the Town of Polar will provide their own insurance for fire apparatus owned by the Town of Polar effective January 20, 2017. Wayne seconded. Motion carried. Nathan Walrath took the signed agreement with him.

Surveyor Tim Rusch reviewed the bid ads for the Tri-D East 8th Avenue project with the Board. The ads will be run as Class 2 notices with two insertions once a week for two weeks at least one week before bids are due. The Board will open the bids at our next Monthly Board Meeting on March 8th at 7:30 p.m. and award the bid at a Special Board Meeting on March 10th at 12 p.m.

The Board reviewed possible town residents to be asked to be part of the comprehensive plan update committee.

A motion was made by Jon to approve an operator license for Stephanie Young for the period 2/8/17 – 6/30/17. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.

Rick motioned that the zoning revert back from Commercial to A-1 for Parcel #006-0115.01 at W9852 Cherry Road. Wayne seconded. Motion carried. A copy of the minutes will be forwarded to Duane Haakenson at the Langlade County Records & Regulations department for recording the change.

The Board audited the clerk and treasurer's books. The clerk and treasurer's records agreed with each other and the bank statements. The Board agreed that all appeared in order and Wayne motioned to approve the audit. Jon seconded. Motion carried. The Board signed the December 31, 2016 balance sheet with a balance of \$620,459.96.

Wayne motioned to enforce weight limits when posted for: Orchard Road, from Highway 64 to Cty. Rd. F; Clover Road, from Highway 52 to Highway 64; Meadow Road, from Highway 64 to Cty. Rd. F; Dorr Street, from Cty. Rd. Y to Cty. Rd. X; Parkway Road, from Cty. Rd. F to Maplevue Road; Maplevue Road, from Highway 45 east to Parkway Road; Western Avenue from Cty. Rd. X to Cty. Rd. Y; and to close Schroeder Road when needed. Jon seconded. Motion carried.

The treasurer's report showed a checking balance of \$5,734.06, savings balance of \$459,842.86 and tax account balance of \$211.47 for a total of \$465,788.39. The fire department has a balance of \$120,949.79.

Our next Board Meeting will be held on Wednesday, March 8th at 7:30 p.m.

There will be a Special Board Meeting held on Friday, March 10th at 12 p.m. to award the bids on the Tri-D project for East 8th Avenue.

All approved bills were paid.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:45 p.m.
