

**Town of Antigo
Town Board Meeting
January 11, 2017**

Chairperson Rick Parilek called the Monthly Board Meeting to order on January 11, 2017 at 7:15 p.m. following the Town Caucus at the Antigo Town Hall. Other Board members present were Supervisor Jon Petroskey, Supervisor Wayne Schroeder, Clerk Rosemary Servi and Treasurer Cindy Igl. Also present was Mike Winski and Bob Lynett, members of the Town of Antigo Volunteer Fire Department.

The clerk read the minutes of the prior month's meeting. The minutes were approved with a motion by Jon and second by Wayne. Motion carried.

Bob and Mike stated that the fire department would like to take trucks that need repair in the future to Doc Spencer Trucking as they have had the best results with them. The Board saw no problem with the request.

Alex Hafner, from the Town of Antigo Volunteer Fire Department, arrived.

The fire department has not heard anything on their 2016 grant for air packs but they are applying again for the grant in 2017.

Rosemary stated that Tim Rusch contacted her on the East Eighth Avenue project. Tim will be bringing the specs and plans to the Board Meeting next month for the Board to review and then put out for bids.

A motion was made by Jon and seconded by Wayne to adopt the updated Emergency Operations Plan which now includes the Emergency Election Site Agreement with the Unified School District of Antigo for Spring Valley School. Motion carried. Jon will give a copy of the updated plan to Brad Henricks, who is with Langlade County Emergency Management.

The treasurer's report showed a checking balance of \$6,360.51, savings balance of \$492,809.77 and tax account balance of \$211.47 for a total of \$499,381.75. The fire department has a balance of \$120,878.21.

A notice of a minor subdivision application was received from the Langlade County Land Records and Regulations office for Sandra Krajewski. Sandra is creating a 3.194 acre lot off of County Hwy. V.

Jon motioned to sign the 2017 Joint Powers Agreement County 911 Emergency System agreement with the Langlade County Sheriff's Office. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.

Our next Board Meeting will be held on Wednesday, February 8th at 7:30 p.m.

All approved bills were paid.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:25 p.m.
