

**Town of Antigo
Town Board Meeting
July 13, 2016**

Chairperson Rick Parilek called the Monthly Board Meeting to order on July 13, 2016 at 7:30 p.m. at the Antigo Town Hall. Other Board members present were Supervisor Jon Petroskey, Supervisor Wayne Schroeder, Clerk Rosemary Servi and Treasurer Cindy Igl. Also present was Surveyor Tim Rusch.

The clerk read the minutes of the prior month's meeting. The minutes were approved with a motion by Jon and second by Wayne. Motion carried.

Surveyor Tim Rusch updated the Board on the East 8th Avenue TRIPD project. The road will need to be closed for about 3 days with a temporary highway needed. Land owners, Nicholas & Sara Krueger and the Frisch Family Trust have agreed to allow the temporary highway on their property. Wayne motioned that the Board sign Resolution #1-15 Order for temporary highway. Jon seconded. Motion carried. Jon motioned to amend Resolution #1-15 to add the temporary highway has a weight restriction of 10,000 pounds and a speed limit of 10 m.p.h. Wayne seconded. Motion carried. The Town Board will discuss with the Town of Antigo Volunteer Fire Department having a preplan to cover emergency service vehicles using the temporary highway. A letter will be sent to the residences affected by the temporary highway before work would begin letting them know when it will happen, suggesting minimal traffic during that time, letting them know of the 10 m.p.h. speed limit and the 10,000 pound weight restriction limit, and informing them that no large equipment should use the temporary highway other than emergency service vehicles. Tim Rusch will update the Board next month on the project's progress.

Rick spoke to Duane Haakenson in the Langlade County Land Records and Regulations Department in regard to Justin Eldridge and Tresha Vaughn's rezoning request for parcel #006-0473.001 from A-1 to Commercial for an auto repair business at W8339 Forrest Road. Duane told Rick that no conditional use permit could be issued on this property unless it was rezoned commercial. The Town would have to ask that the zoning revert back to A-1 if the property was sold. The Board tabled the request.

On July 7, 2016, Brian Braun from the Langlade County Highway Department, landowner Tom Wild, Wayne Schroeder and Jon Petroskey met on the corner of Hafemeister Lane and Ar-Vi Lane to consider signage options. It was recommended to put in a stop sign with right turn no stop and a stop ahead sign. Wayne motioned to go with the recommended stop sign with right turn no stop and a stop ahead sign. Jon seconded. Motion carried.

The treasurer's report showed a checking balance of \$5,449.68, savings balance of \$420,494.13 and tax account balance of \$175,529.34 for a total of \$601,473.15. The fire department has a balance of \$97,460.68.

There will be a primary election on Tuesday, August 9th.

Our next Board Meeting will be held on Wednesday, August 10th at 7:30 p.m.

All approved bills were paid.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:10 p.m.
