

**Town of Antigo
Town Board Meeting
June 11, 2014**

Chairperson Rick Parilek called the Monthly Board Meeting to order on June 11, 2014 at 7:30 p.m. at the Antigo Town Hall. Other Board members present were Supervisor Jon Petroskey, Supervisor Wayne Schroeder, Clerk Rosemary Servi and Treasurer Cindy Igl.

The clerk read the minutes of the prior month's meeting. The minutes were approved with a motion by Wayne and second by Jon. Motion carried.

Crack sealing bids were opened. Present was Brian Braun from Fahrner Asphalt Sealers. Fahrner Asphalt Sealers bid \$7,479 for crack sealing Pioneer Road and \$791.10 for crack sealing Crestwood Road for a total of \$8,270.10. Estimates were received from the Langlade County Highway Department for \$5,890 for crack sealing Pioneer Road and \$1,386 for crack sealing Crestwood Road for a total of \$7,276. Jon motioned to go with the Langlade County estimates for crack sealing totaling \$7,276. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.

Pete Pennington, representing the Antigo ATV Club, addressed the Board regarding the request to make Angle Road an ATV Route. There were 10 town residents and 21 nonresidents in attendance. The City of Antigo has approved the use of the railroad corridor to County Highway N for an ATV trail. They will be using the railroad corridor owned by the Railroad from County Highway N to Angle Road as an ATV trail. They are requesting the Board make Angle Road an ATV Route. This would allow them to get to the Town of Neva where they would have to request road use as an ATV Route to go further north. Angle Road as an ATV Route would also allow people to get to Rick's 45 Roadhouse. The Antigo ATV Club stated that they would put up the needed signage (ATV Route, speed limit, large machinery, etc.) and maintain it. Langlade County Sheriff Bill Greening told them that there are no problems with ATVs on roads right now in Langlade County. They spoke to land owners Tom Wild and Igl's who have no concerns with an ATV Route. They feel there would be a positive financial impact with an ATV Route out of Antigo. They would like the town to try through 2015. The Board concerns are having ATVs on the road with farm machinery since we are mainly an agricultural township, the additional liability exposure for the town, the fact that ATVs are not recommended for use on blacktop roads, and that there are no shoulders on Angle Road. Jon motioned to make Angle Road an ATV Route through October 31, 2015, unless problems occur in which case the Route can be closed. There was no second. Rick motioned to table the discussion to next month so it can be looked into further. Wayne seconded. An oral vote was taken. Ayes – Rick and Wayne. Opposed – Jon. Motion carried.

Estimates were received from the Langlade County Highway Department for the following: Industrial Park Road Paving \$11,650; Hafemeister Lane/Violet Way Paving \$10,550; Ar-Vi Lane Paving \$14,620; East 8th Avenue Patch \$1,690; Western Avenue Paving \$5,300; and Barske Road Paving \$9,920, for a total of \$53,730. Wayne motioned to go with the estimates received from the Langlade County Highway Department totaling \$53,730. Jon seconded. Motion carried.

The treasurer's report showed a checking balance of \$6,906.28, savings balance of \$502,294.47 and tax account balance of \$10.00 for a total of \$509,210.75.

Our next Board Meeting will be held on Wednesday, July 9th at 7:30 p.m.

All approved bills were paid.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:50 p.m.
