

**Town of Antigo
Town Board Meeting
June 7, 2017**

Chairperson Rick Parilek called the Monthly Board Meeting to order on June 7, 2017 at 7:30 p.m. at the Antigo Town Hall. Other board members present were Supervisor Jon Petroskey, Supervisor Wayne Schroeder, Clerk Rosemary Servi and Treasurer Cindy Igl. Also present was Surveyor Tim Rusch, resident Tamura Gaffey, Dennis Tatro and Assessor Gene Matuszewski, Jr.

The clerk read the minutes of the prior month's meeting. The minutes were approved with a motion by Jon and second by Wayne. Motion carried.

Surveyor Tim Rusch stated that Duffeks are behind schedule in starting the East 8th Avenue project. They are now hoping to do the prep work next week and close the street for work on Monday, June 19th. Roger Wissbroecker and his brother contacted Tim regarding moving the planned driveway over slightly. The Board was fine with the request and Tim will change the temporary limited easement to reflect the change.

Rick stated that Mike Kennedy, Town of Ackley Chairperson, went to the Wisconsin Towns Association regarding the land between the Town of Antigo and Town of Ackley. They recommended first having the landowners try to work things out.

Resident Tamura Gaffey addressed the Board regarding her request to change a 3-acre parcel #006-0392.002 located on County Highway F from A-1 to AFR to build a house. Jon motioned to approve the request. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Jon to appoint Gene Matuszewski, Jr. as the Town Assessor for the period 8/1/17 through 7/31/18. Wayne seconded the motion. Gene will be a town employee with his salary at \$1,539.17 per month. These wages will include Open Book and the Board of Review. Gene has agreed to keep the town in compliance with the state. Gene also agreed to adhere to all State of WI requirements, value all new construction, value all personal property, complete the assessment roll, appear at the Open Book and Board of Review, use current value guidelines for agricultural assessment, stamps and pictures, etc., provided by the town, and the annual assessment report completed. Motion carried. Gene completed his oath of office.

The fire department submitted estimates to the Board for new tires for Engine #1. The estimate from Southside Tire was for \$2,494.50 and from Pomp's Tire Service for \$2,458.50. Jon motioned to go with the estimate from Southside Tire for \$2,494.50 with getting the old tires back and Wayne working on getting something for them. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Rick to go with the Langlade County Highway Department's estimate for: Mourning Dove Lane, Entire road (950') \$8,932; Spruce Lane, Entire road (692' + cul-de-sac) \$8,450; Clover Road culvert pipe replacement \$4,723; and Clover Road wedge over pipes \$1,875 for a total of \$23,980. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.

The treasurer's report showed a checking balance of \$12,892.42, savings account balance of \$452,336.72 and tax account balance of \$185,247.42 for a total of \$650,476.56. The fire department has a balance of \$121,247.48.

Our next Board Meeting will be held on Wednesday, July 12th at 7:30 p.m.

All approved bills were paid.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:55 p.m.
