

**Town of Antigo  
Town Board Meeting  
May 10, 2017**

Chairperson Rick Parilek called the Monthly Board Meeting to order on May 10, 2017 at 7:30 p.m. at the Antigo Town Hall. Other Board members present were Supervisor Jon Petroskey, Supervisor Wayne Schroeder, Clerk Rosemary Servi and Treasurer Cindy Igl. Also present was Surveyor Tim Rusch, Taylor Tauer from Northeast Asphalt, Inc., Nick Novy from American Asphalt of Wisconsin, Brian Braun from the Langlade County Highway Department, Mike Kennedy, Town of Ackley Chairperson, resident Tamura Gaffey and Dennis Tatro.

The clerk read the minutes of the prior month's meeting. The minutes were approved with a motion by Jon and second by Wayne. Motion carried.

The Board opened bids on the LRIP project for Cherry Road. Northeast Asphalt, Inc. bid \$49,162.50; American Asphalt of Wisconsin bid \$53,860.50 and the Langlade County Highway Department estimated \$42,200.36 or \$40,291.32 if they also were awarded the other Cherry Road project. Jon motioned to award the LRIP Project for Cherry Road to the Langlade County Highway Department for \$42,200.36 or \$40,291.32 if they also were awarded the other Cherry Road project.

The Board then opened bids on the second Cherry Road project. Northeast Asphalt, Inc. bid \$71,908.35; American Asphalt of Wisconsin bid \$73,911.53 and the Langlade County Highway Department estimated \$60,257.00 or \$57,531.12 if they also were awarded the LRIP project for Cherry Road. Jon motioned to award the second Cherry Road project to the Langlade County Highway Department for \$57,531.12 since they were awarded the LRIP Cherry Road project.

Surveyor Tim Rusch stated the East 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue project is tentatively set for prep work to begin on May 30<sup>th</sup> and the barricade and project to begin on June 5<sup>th</sup>. Letters were drafted for affected residents and the clerk will mail them on Monday, May 15<sup>th</sup>.

Town of Ackley Chairperson, Mike Kennedy, was present in regard to the land between the Town of Antigo and Town of Ackley. In the Town of Ackley's road book, there was a road set up on April 20, 1935. In 1999, there was an affidavit signed by the Town of Ackley and Town of Antigo Chairpersons establishing a right-of-way, but it was never recorded. Mike will talk to the Wisconsin Towns Association to see how they recommend the towns proceed.

Resident Tamura Gaffey addressed the Board regarding her request to change a 3-acre parcel #006.0392.002 from A-1 to AFR to build a house. Since the item was not on the agenda, the Board could not act on it. The request will be put on the June meeting's agenda.

A motion was made by Jon and seconded by Wayne to approve alcohol beverage licenses contingent upon no problem for Rick's 45 Roadhouse, LLC, Draeger Oil Co., Inc. for CA Northside LLC/BP North, J Dubbs, LLC for J's Archery Pro Shop and for Northern Roots, LLC for the period July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018. Motion carried.

Wayne motioned to approve operator licenses for the period May 10, 2017 through June 30, 2017 for Jessica Koeppel and Wendy Tucker. Jon seconded. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Jon to approve operator licenses for the period July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018 for Jessica Koeppel, Wendy Tucker, Connie Piotrowski, Megan Jaje, Katie Wierschke, Dove Davis, Jenna Wierschke, Alexis Quintana, Sarah Strong, Kathy Wendt,

Rebecca Stewart, Jeremiah Rotzoll, Stephanie Young, April Kolpack, Brian Waldvogel, Jessica Filbrandt and Katelynn Filbrandt. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.

Wayne motioned to appoint Cindy Igl and John McCullough as alternates for the Board of Review. Jon seconded. Motion carried.

The treasurer's report showed a checking balance of \$15,064.35, savings balance of \$451,149.19 and tax account balance of \$185,247.42 for a total of \$651,460.96.

The Board of Review will be held on Tuesday, June 6<sup>th</sup> from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m.
