

**Town of Antigo
Town Board Meeting
May 13, 2015**

Chairperson Rick Parilek called the Monthly Board Meeting to order on May 13, 2015 at 7:30 p.m. at the Antigo Town Hall. Other Board members present were Supervisor Jon Petroskey, Supervisor Wayne Schroeder, Clerk Rosemary Servi and Treasurer Cindy Igl. Also present was John McCullough and Pete Pennington.

The clerk read the minutes of the prior month's meeting. The minutes were approved with a motion by Wayne and second by Jon. Motion carried.

A letter was received from ISO informing us that the Town of Antigo Volunteer Fire Department now has a public protection classification of 6. This rating may possibly benefit both commercial and residential property owners on their insurance premium. The Board wants to put a notice to the residents of the three townships in the Antigo Daily Journal along with a thank you to the fire department.

Jon made a motion to have Rick sign the Public Notice of Inspection to be published for Ordinance #141-1, Amendment to Ordinance #141 All-Terrain Vehicle and Utility Terrain Vehicle Route Ordinance, which is adding on a segment of North Clermont Street. Wayne seconded. Motion carried. This ordinance will be voted on at the June Board Meeting.

A motion was made by Rick and seconded by Wayne to approve alcohol beverage licenses contingent upon no problem for Rick's 45 Roadhouse, LLC, Draeger Oil Co., Inc. for CA Northside LLC/BP North, J Dubbs, LLC for J's Archery Pro Shop and for Northern Roots, LLC. for the period 7/1/15 – 6/30/16. Motion carried.

Jon motioned to approve Operator Licenses for the period 5/13/15 – 6/30/15 for Natosha Zoern, Kelsey Anderson and Jamie Greening. Rick seconded. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Wayne and seconded by Jon to approve Operator Licenses for the period 7/1/15 – 6/30/16 for Katelynn Filbrandt, Jessica Filbrandt, Jillene Kapusta, Jeremiah Rotzoll, Alicia Fassbender, Rebecca Stewart, Jessica Matuszewski, Sarah Strong, Randi McVinnie, Megan Jaje, Ashley Steber, Mindalyn Schmit, Connie Piotrowski, Jamie Greening, Natosha Zoern, Kelsey Anderson and Brian Waldvogel. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Wayne to appoint Cindy Igl, Pete Pennington and John McCullough as alternates for the Board of Review. Jon seconded. Motion carried.

The treasurer's report showed a checking balance of \$12,675.12, savings balance of \$397,395.16 and tax account balance of \$161,959.23 for a total of \$572,029.51.

Jon motioned to purchase 40 Alera steel chairs with padded backs and seats from Clermont Printing, Inc. for \$27.90 each along with a chair rack to hold them. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.
