

**Town of Antigo  
Town Board Meeting  
May 14, 2014**

Chairperson Rick Parilek called the Monthly Board Meeting to order on May 14, 2014 at 7:30 p.m. at the Antigo Town Hall. Other Board members present were Supervisor Jon Petroskey, Supervisor Wayne Schroeder, Clerk Rosemary Servi, and Treasurer Cindy Igl.

The clerk read the minutes of the prior month's meeting. The minutes were approved with a motion by Wayne and second by Jon. Motion carried.

Duane Haakenson, Langlade County Zoning Administrator, and Robin Stowe, Langlade County Corporation Counsel, were present in regard to a possible zoning violation special assessment agreement with Langlade County. When there are costs incurred for zoning violations, the County would like the Town to bill the property owner for those special charges. If the property owner does not pay the bill, those costs would be added as a special charge on the property tax bill. The Town and County would each need to pass a resolution and also enter into an intergovernmental agreement. Robin Stowe will contact Paul Payant, the town's attorney, in regard to the legal documents needed.

Duane stated that the County is redoing their zoning maps and farmland preservation plan this year so that they can revise the County's Ag Zoning Law to be in compliance. Duane will let the townships know when there will be a public hearing on this.

A motion was made by Jon and seconded by Wayne to approve alcohol beverage licenses contingent upon no problem for Rick's 45 Roadhouse, LLC, Draeger Oil Co., Inc. for BP North, J Dubbs, LLC for J's Archery Pro Shop and Robert and Nancy Hunter for Northern Roots, LLC. for the period 7/1/14 – 6/30/15. Motion carried.

Wayne motioned to approve Operator Licenses for the period 7/1/14 – 6/30/15 for the following: Brian Waldvogel, Haylee Shields, Megan Jaje, Ashley Steber, Mindalyn Schmit, Connie Piotrowski, Jessica Filbrandt, Jeremiah Rotzoll, Jillene Kapusta and Patrick Bultman. Jon seconded. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Jon to appoint Wayne Dieck, Pete Pennington and Cindy Igl as alternates for the Board of Review. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.

The treasurer's report showed a checking balance of \$6,207.96, savings balance of \$516,324.07 and tax account balance of \$10.00 for a total of \$522,542.03.

Rick motioned that the town hire Wiley Petroskey to help with road maintenance at \$12 per hour. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.

The Board of Review will be held on June 3<sup>rd</sup> from 7 p.m. – 9 p.m.

Our next Board Meeting will be held on Wednesday, June 11<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 p.m.

All approved bills were paid.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:55 p.m.
