

**Town of Antigo
Town Board Meeting
May 8, 2013**

Chairperson Rick Parilek called the Monthly Board Meeting to order on May 8, 2013 at 7:30 p.m. at the Antigo Town Hall. Other Board members present were Supervisor Jon Petroskey, Supervisor Wayne Schroeder, Clerk Rosemary Servi and Treasurer Cindy Igl. Also present were Ray Gausmann from American Asphalt of Wisconsin, Taylor Tauer from Northeast Asphalt, Inc. and John Fink from Pitlik & Wick, Inc.

The clerk read the minutes of the prior month's meeting. The minutes were approved with a motion by Wayne and seconded by Jon. Motion carried.

Crack sealing bids were opened for Flight Road and Parkway Road. Fahrner Asphalt Sealers bid \$3,788 for Flight Road and \$526 for Parkway Road for a total of \$4,314. Pitlik & Wick bid \$6,584 for Flight Road and \$611 for Parkway Road for a total of \$7,195. Langlade County Highway Department estimated \$2,756 for Flight Road and \$1,080 for Parkway Road for a total of \$3,836. Jon motioned to go with the Langlade County Highway Department estimate of \$2,756 for Flight Road and \$1,080 for Parkway Road for a total of \$3,836 for crack sealing. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.

Bids for pulverizing, paving and shouldering of Kelly Street were opened. American Asphalt bid \$15,143. Northeast Asphalt, Inc. bid \$18,267.60. Langlade County estimated \$14,030 but their estimate did not use the correct road width. Rick motioned to go with the American Asphalt bid of \$15,143 for pulverizing, paving and shouldering of Kelly Street. Jon seconded. Motion carried.

Wayne motioned to go with Langlade County and their estimate of \$6,760 for patching North Clermont Street. Jon seconded. Motion carried.

Dale Doucette was present in regard to the open constable position. He will be having knee surgery and would not be interested at this time. If the position would still be open after his recovery, which he thinks would be in August, he might consider it.

A motion was made by Jon to close part of Industrial Park Road and North Clermont Street on Saturday, May 18th for the Stand for Children's Day event. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.

Jon motioned to appoint Wayne Dieck, Pete Pennington and Cindy Igl as alternates for the Board of Review. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.

The treasurer's report showed a checking balance of \$7,489.26, savings balance of \$490,258.14 and tax account balance of \$10.00 for a total of \$497,757.40.

Gene Matuszewski was present and set the Open Book for Tuesday, June 4th from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m.

The Board of Review will be on Tuesday, June 11th from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m.

Our next Board Meeting will be held on Wednesday, June 12th at 7:30 p.m.

All approved bills were paid.

A motion was made to adjourn by Jon at 9:25 p.m. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.
