Notice is hereby given that on Wednesday, November 11, 2015, immediately following the completion of the Public Hearing on the proposed 2016 budget, which begins at 7 p.m. at the Antigo Town Hall, a special town meeting of the electors called pursuant to Sec. 60.12(1)(c) of Wis. Stats. by the town board for the following purpose will be held:

1. To consider the adoption of a resolution by the town meeting endorsing a town board resolution which proposes that the town levy exceed the state allowable levy limit under Sec. 66.0602 of Wis. Statutes, specifically a proposed tax levy which would exceed the allowable town tax levy for 2015 By 5.97 percent which would be a dollar increase of \$15,000.
 2. To adopt the 2015 town tax levy to be paid in 2016 pursuant to Sec. 60.10(1)(a) of Wis. Stats.
