

**Town of Antigo  
Public Budget Hearing  
Special Town Meeting of the Electors  
Monthly Board Meeting  
November 14, 2012**

Chairperson Rick Parilek called the Public Budget Hearing to order on November 14, 2012 at 7 p.m. at the Town Hall. Other Board members present were Supervisor Jon Petroskey, Supervisor Wayne Schroeder, Clerk Rosemary Servi and Treasurer Cindy Igl. Also present was Gene Matuszewski.

The proposed Budget of \$383,200 was reviewed. The budget is a .47% increase. Wayne motioned to adjourn the Public Budget Hearing. Gene Matuszewski seconded. There were 6 ayes and no nays. Motion carried.

The Special Town Meeting of the Electors was called to order.

A motion was made by Cindy to adopt Resolution #3-12 adopting the 2012 levy to be collected in 2013 in the amount of \$246,050. Wayne seconded. There were 6 ayes and no nays. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Jon to set the compensation for town elected officials to be elected on April 2, 2013 and to hold the term of office from April 16, 2013 for two years totaling \$48,656. There is also \$20 per diem payable to the Constable any Board Member who takes in a stray if they can't get a hold of the Constable. Wayne seconded. There were 6 ayes and no nays. Motion carried.

A motion to adjourn the Special Town Meeting of the Electors was made by Wayne and seconded by Jon. There were 6 ayes and no nays. Motion carried.

The Monthly Board Meeting was called to order. Also present were Jim Frisch, Becky Frisch and Cal Krueger.

The clerk read the minutes of the prior month's meeting. The minutes were approved with a motion by Wayne and second by Jon. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Jon to adopt the 2013 budget of \$383,200 for the Town of Antigo. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.

Attorney Paul Payant is putting together resolutions to vacate East Ninth Avenue and Sun Dance Drive. Paul will also put the notice in the paper and mail out notices to all adjacent land owners for the hearing in January.

Quotes were received for painting the 1996 International fire truck from Parsons for \$776 and Jerry's Auto Body for \$504. The Board prefers Parson's work and they can do the fire truck in one day. Jon motioned to go with Parson's quote of \$776 for painting the 1996 International fire truck. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.

The treasurer's report showed a checking balance of \$33,529.96, savings balance of \$404,871.38 and tax account balance of \$44.74 for a total of \$438,446.08.

Fire protection contracts with Polar and Price were presented. Jon motioned to sign the contract with Polar for \$10,511 plus the EMS charge of \$171 and with Price for \$9,490 plus the EMS charge of \$42. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.

Our next Board Meeting will be held on Wednesday, December 12<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 p.m.

Our January Board Meeting will be held on Wednesday, January 9<sup>th</sup> following the 7 p.m. hearing on vacating East Ninth Avenue and Sun Dance Drive.

All approved bills were paid.

A motion was made to adjourn by Jon at 8:20 p.m. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.
