

**Town of Antigo  
Public Budget Hearing  
Special Town Meeting of the Electors  
Monthly Board Meeting  
November 16, 2016**

Chairperson Rick Parilek called the Public Budget Hearing to order on November 16, 2016 at 7 p.m. at the Antigo Town Hall. Other Board members present were Supervisor Jon Petroskey, Supervisor Wayne Schroeder, Clerk Rosemary Servi and Treasurer Cindy Igl.

The proposed budget of \$417,373 was reviewed. The budget is a 1.85% increase.

Jon motioned to adjourn the Public Budget Hearing. Wayne seconded. A show of hands vote was taken. There were five in favor. No one opposed. Motion carried.

The Special Town Meeting of the Electors was called to order.

A motion was made by Wayne to pass Resolution #6-16 for Electors to Adopt the Town Tax Levy at a Special Town Meeting of the Electors of \$272,407 for the 2016 tax levy to be collected in 2017. Jon seconded. A show of hands vote was taken. There were five in favor. No one opposed. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Wayne to adjourn the Special Town Meeting of the Electors. Jon seconded. A show of hands vote was taken. There were five in favor. No one opposed. Motion carried.

The Monthly Board Meeting was called to order.

The clerk read the minutes of the prior month's meeting. The minutes were approved with a motion by Jon and second by Wayne. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Wayne to adopt the 2017 summary budget of \$417,373 as published in the Antigo Daily Journal. Jon seconded. Motion carried.

The zoning request from Tresha Vaughn and Justin Eldridge from A-1 to Commercial was tabled as no one present in regard to the zoning change.

In regard to the East 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue project, Tim Rusch emailed Rosemary that the concrete box culverts are on order and Weiser Concrete has provided approval drawings which Tim has approved. The culverts are scheduled for production and they will invoice us when done.

Jon motioned to sign the agreement with the Langlade County Humane Society, Inc. through 2020 on the condition that the Langlade County Humane Society supplies the town with the animal notices they want posted. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.

Fire protection contracts for 2017 with Polar and Price were presented. Wayne motioned to sign the contract with Polar for \$12,062 plus the EMS charge of \$0 and with Price for \$10,890 plus the EMS charge of \$0. Jon seconded. Motion carried. Contracts will be sent to Polar and Price for their signatures.

A motion was made by Jon and seconded by Wayne to approve operator licenses for Skye Jueck and Kelsey Anderson for the period ending June 30, 2017. Motion carried.

The treasurer's report showed a checking balance of \$13,098.69, savings balance of \$449,880.32 and tax account balance of \$175,705.87 for a total of \$638,684.88. The fire department has a balance of \$97,633.66.

Wayne motioned to sign the Intergovernmental Agreement for the Provision of Emergency Ambulance Services for 2017 with the City of Antigo for \$51,358.00. Rick seconded. Jon abstained. Motion carried.

All approved bills were paid.
