

**Town of Antigo  
Town Board Meeting  
October 17, 2012**

Chairperson Rick Parilek called the Monthly Board Meeting to order on October 17, 2012 at 7:30 p.m. at the Antigo Town Hall. Other Board members present were Supervisor Jon Petroskey, Supervisor Wayne Schroeder, Clerk Rosemary Servi and Treasurer Cindy Igl.

The clerk read the minutes of the prior month's meeting. The minutes were approved with a motion by Wayne and second by Jon. Motion carried.

Jolene Welch was present in regard to the Thomas and Jolene Welch zoning request from R1 to R2 on the 6.8-acre parcel #006-0616.02 on Forrest Road. They would like to have a split-level house as a 2-family duplex. Jon motioned to approve the request. Wayne seconded. An oral vote was taken. Rick – Aye. Jon – Aye. Wayne – Aye. Motion carried. The County's Water and Land Use Planning Committee form was completed and will be forwarded to them.

Jon motioned that the Board pass and sign Resolution #2-12 Resolution in Support of a Constitutional Amendment for Fair Share for Local Roads. Wayne seconded. Motion carried. Copies of the signed resolution will be sent to the Wisconsin Towns Association, Assemblyman Tom Tiffany and Senator Jim Holperin.

Rick motioned to sign Resolution #4-12 authorizing that the Town of Antigo will not be mailing checks for overpaid real estate taxes less than \$5.00. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.

The treasurer's report showed a checking balance of \$6,406.40, savings balance of \$404,816.61 and tax account balance of \$44.74 for a total of \$411,267.75.

Rick motioned that the Board sign the Purchasing Agreement with Assessment Technologies of Wisconsin, LLC for Market Drive 2012 for our assessor. Jon seconded. Motion carried.

There will be an election on Tuesday, November 6<sup>th</sup>.

Our November Board Meeting will be held on Wednesday, November 14<sup>th</sup> following the 7 p.m. Public Budget Hearing and Special Town Meeting of the Electors.

All approved bills were paid.

A motion was made to adjourn by Wayne at 9:05 p.m. Jon seconded. Motion carried.
