

**TOWN OF POLAR REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING  
HELD ON NOVEMBER 17, 2016**

5:09 pm Meeting was called to order by Chairman, Nathan Walrath. Present were, Chairman; Nathan Walrath, Supervisor I; Terry Kolpack, Supervisor II; Paul Schuman, Clerk; Jane Kolpack, Treasurer; Carol Estreen, with 10 citizens in attendance.

October Minutes: Motion made by Nate to abstain from the reading of the minutes; second by, Terry, motion carried. Motion made by Nate to accept the minutes as printed with one correction change SBVAs to SCBAs; second by, Paul, motion carried.

Treasurer/Financial Report: Treasurer; Carol Estreen read the treasurer's report. Motion made by Nate to accept the report as read; second by, Paul, motion carried.

Fire Department/Finance Report: Fire Department report was read by, Nate. Motion made by Paul to accept the report; second by, Nate, motion carried.

Road/Finance Report: Road/Finance Report was read by Paul. Motion made by Nate to accept the report; second by, Terry, motion carried.

Correspondence: Letter from Tammy Baldwin regarding the Town of Polar's resolution and need for a sustainable transportation system. DNR regarding MFL land that will take effect on 01/01/2017. Information from the veterinary services in town in regards to hiring a humane officer.

Public Comment: Question regarding road issues in the township were addressed. Carol indicated that they want to increase the dog license by double, we have the right to not increase the fee but the county encourages it as the funds help the humane society.

Roads: Terry addressed Price-Polar Road where Dave Cunningham lives there is 1500 feet distance where the black top is broke off and needed to be removed; gravel would be added to the road and then graded with no black top this year, estimated cost from the highway department would be \$1,200.00. Concerns were addressed regarding shouldering on Price-Polar Road, Short Cut Road and Rabe Lane. Nate indicated that the county has started the brushing, patching and patrolling roads. Nate is still waiting on some more information on the Buckthorn by Muellers Lake.

Fire Department: Truck is still a work in progress and is serviceable but it cannot be used as an emergency vehicle.

Amendment to Implements of Husbandry Ordinance and Permit: Motion made by Paul to accept the amended Implements of Husbandry Ordinance; second by; Terry, motion carried.

Approve 2017 Budget: Budget was approved at the Special Town Meeting of Electors prior to the regular meeting.

Pay Bills: Motion made to pay the bills by Paul; second by, Nate, motion carried.

Adjourn: With no other business to come before the board, Terry made the motion to adjourn; second by, Nate, motion carried.
