

**TOWN OF POLAR SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
ADOPT AN ORDINANCE FOR IMPLEMENTS OF HUSBANDRY
HELD ON NOVEMBER 23, 2015**

The meeting and agenda were posted in the Antigo Daily Journal, on the town hall bulletin board and the Langlade County website.

5:02 pm Meeting was called to order by Chairman, Nathan Walrath. Present were, Chairman; Nathan Walrath, Supervisor I; Terry Kolpack, Supervisor II; Paul Schuman, Clerk; Jane Kolpack, with 2 citizens in attendance.

The purpose of the meeting was to adopt an ordinance for Implements of Husbandry based on information provided by the Wisconsin Towns Association and to be in union with the surrounding townships of; Town of Price and Town of Wolf River.

Three options were addressed; "Option E" with a permit and bond requirement for manure haulers, "Option E" with no permit and bond requirement for manure haulers and "Option D" with no permit and bond requirement for manure haulers.

"Option E" with a permit and bond requirement will exempt vehicles up to 20 ton. This is the exact same option that both the Town of Price and the Town of Wolf River have adopted.

After discussion on the options available for the adoption of the Implements of Husbandry provided by the Wisconsin Towns Association; Nate made the motion to accept "Option E" with the additional requirements of manure haulers; second by, Terry, motion carried with 3 Ayes and 0 Nays.

Adjourn: Nate made the motion to adjourn; second by, Terry, motion carried. Meeting Adjourned at 5:53 pm.
