Ordinance No. 1509

The Town Board of the Town of Polar, Langlade County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.11, Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.


This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the reduction of the speed limits on certain town highways in the town as follows:

- A. Pursuant to s. 349.11, Wis. stats., effective October 1, 2015, the speed limit on certain Town of Polar town highways are reduced or modified as follows:
Hill Road north of State Highway 64 to the intersection of Edison Road reduced from 55 miles per hour to 45 miles per hour.
- B. Pursuant to s. 349.11 (5) Wis. stats., the town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs at the above-described locations on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No persons shall operate any vehicle on the above-noted town highway in violation of the above-noted speed limits. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 346.60, Wis. stats.


This ordinance is effective on October 1, 2015.


