

January 11, 2012

The regular monthly town board meeting as posted at Mike's Service, Strong's, Bob's Northern Lights and the town hall and advertised in the Antigo Daily Journal was called to order by Chairman Casper Buettner. Also present were Supervisors Susan Hawley and William Majest, Linda Frank, treasurer and Mary Lee Heise, clerk, along with Mike and Sharon Steckbauer.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given by all those present.

The agenda was approved upon motion by Supervisor Hawley and seconded by Supervisor Majest, motion carried.

The minutes of the December meeting were approved upon motion by Supervisor Majest and seconded by Supervisor Hawley, motion carried.

The treasurer's report was read by Linda Frank. A motion to approve the report was made by Supervisor Hawley and seconded by Supervisor Majest, motion carried.

Non-board member business: None

New Business: Road name changes to parts of Buettner Road-the county has informed the board that they will be contacting the people on those parts of Buettner road to be changed and that the town will not have to do anything. A resolution prepared for these changes was read by the clerk. The resolution will be retyped, with changes, and will be presented at the February meeting. Specific fire numbers are needed to complete the resolution.

Dan Nelson was to be at this meeting concerning his driveway along Sawyer Lake Road. This matter will not be taken up at this meeting but, rather, at the February meeting. Mr. Nelson wants to change the driveway to his residence. Chairman Buettner showed the board a map showing the change. The driveway is between two residences. The town does not want to get involved in a feud between two neighbors and feels that this may be the case.

Community Development Housing Block Grant. The board received a resolution concerning the housing grant that has been made available to our township. The resolution was read by the clerk. A motion was made by Supervisor Hawley and seconded by Supervisor Majest to adopt the resolution, motion carried. The resolution was signed and dated and will be returned.

General Building and Plant – Nothing new to report.

Highway – We have only had to plow twice. The roads are sanded. Brushing is now being done. Bids for the logging to be done on Sawyer Lake Road will be let out on January 16th. The logging is to be done by summer.

Fire Department – The appreciation dinner was held at the Wild Wolf Inn.

Rescue Squad – Everything is going well. There have been 3 runs so far this year.

Cemetery – Nothing new to report except that the funeral for Erna Allen will be on Saturday.

Correspondence – Ryan Brown sent an explanation of managed forest law entries. A letter was received from the county concerning the Statement of Taxes to be done. A reminder was received from the Government Accountability Board concerning the accessibility of our polling place and requesting a response. A survey was received from John Deere that will be completed and returned. The annual Joint Powers agreement with the City of Antigo was reviewed and signed upon motion by Supervisor Hawley and seconded by Supervisor Majest, motion carried. A letter was received from Wisconsin Public Service requesting that we inform them of new projects or inspections that we will be doing. The newest Town's Association booklet was reviewed. The Town's Association meeting will be on March 23rd at Carter. The clerk went to a WisLine class in Antigo concerning voter I.D. She discussed upcoming changes with the board.

January bills were approved for payments upon motion by Supervisor Hawley and seconded by Supervisor Majest, motion carried.

Motion to adjourn was made by Supervisor Hawley and seconded by Supervisor Majest, motion carried.
