

March 12, 2015

Regular monthly town board meeting, as published in the Antigo Daily Journal and posted at Mike's Service, Bob's Northern Lights and the town hall was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Chairman Casper Buettner. Also present were Supervisor Susan Hawley and Jim Tilkens, Linda Frank, treasurer and Mary Lee Heise, Clerk.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given by all those present.

The agenda was approved upon motion by Supervisor Hawley and seconded by Supervisor Tilkens, motion carried.

Minutes of the February meeting were approved upon motion by Supervisor Hawley and seconded by Supervisor Tilkens, motion carried.

The treasurer's report was given by Linda Frank. The report was thereafter approved upon motion by Supervisor Hawley and seconded by Supervisor Tilkens, motion carried.

Non-Board member business: None

Unfinished Business: Property that the town wishes to purchase by the highway building - a letter has been sent to owner with the town's offer to purchase. No response has yet been received.

New Business: Liquor license for the Bear Paw. Eric Scharenbrock came before the board with regard to his license for the Bear Paw which he recently purchased. The board discussed the business and the community and what it has to offer. Licenses are good until June 30, 2015. License was thereafter approved upon motion by Supervisor Hawley and seconded by Tilkens, motion approved.

Outside lights: Better lighting for the parking lots in front of the highway shop and fire department has been looked into. Motion to approve having these lights installed for safety reasons by Supervisor Hawley and seconded by Supervisor Tilkens, motion carried.

Holding tank Agreement - Town chose to table this matter.

Floor Tiling – The kitchen and hallway need new flooring. Someone has been contacted to give an estimate for tiling these areas. An estimate of \$1200 has been received. The tiling installation will be put out on bids. Clerk will prepare bid for paper. Board will look into this further and finalize this at the April board meeting. The moving of the old town safe was discussed. If it is going to be moved...it will have to be done before the new flooring is installed.

General Building and Plant – Sewer line had to be thawed by Heinzen Plumbing. Alex will replace the septic pipe that froze after everything thaws.

Highway – Roads are really getting bad. After the road review, we will decide what roadwork has to be done. Road limit signs have been posted and notice has been put in paper and Bob's and Mike's service.

Fire Department – Fire Department Auxiliary is looking into online fundraising. The Fire Department has received a Grant for \$1000.

Rescue Squad - year to date the squad has had 24 runs. Last year there were 25 runs. There are 3 new EMT students taking training.

Recycling Center - Everything is running well.

Cemetery – Everything is quiet.

Correspondence – New locks for the voting machine have been ordered. Discussion on bill to Wabeno School District for the Feb 17 Wabeno School District election. The bill came to \$619.14. Letter sent to state representatives regarding County Assessment verses Town Assessment and how the town opposes this. Other correspondence received from the state and county was reviewed.

Bills submitted were approved by Supervisor Hawley and seconded by Supervisor Tilkens.

The meeting was adjourned upon motion by Supervisor Tilkens and seconded by Supervisor Hawley, motion carried.
