

May 14, 2014 Regular monthly town board meeting, as posted at the town hall, Mike's Service, Bob's Northern Lights and notice having been published in the Antigo Daily Journal, was called to order at 6:30 P.M. by Chairman Casper Buettner. Also present were Supervisors Susan Hawley and Jim Tilkens, Linda Frank treasurer and Mary Lee Heise, clerk.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given by all those present.

The agenda was approved upon motion by Supervisor Hawley and seconded by Supervisor Tilkens, motion carried.

The treasurer's report was given by Linda Frank. \$10,000 has been transferred to a new reassessment CD. National Forest Income check has been received. Thereafter, the report was approved upon motion by Supervisor Hawley and seconded by Supervisor Tilkens, motion carried.

Non-board members and non-board member business:

Unfinished Business: Stream crossing on Hollister Road – Update. Supervisor Tilkens talked to Jim Boreysenko. Mr. Borysenko will be requesting for bids after the 4th of July. Corey and Brian Stone, Kay Majest and Cole Stone and David Stone will be sent a notice for their approval to use the access road that will be used during the project. Discussion on cost of this project along with other roadwork to be done.

New Business: Set Road Review Date – Tuesday, May 20th starting at 7 a.m.

Andy Kostelny – Field Work –Shinner Farms own property in the area and are going to spread semi tankers of liquid manure. The chairman has discussed the town's concerns regarding the town roads that may be used. Andy has stated that, as much as possible, he will not use the town road as he has other access to those properties.
