

September 10, 2014

Monthly town board meeting as advertised in the Antigo Daily Journal, posted at Mike's Service and the town hall was called to order at 6:30 P.M. by Chairman Casper Buettner. Also present were Supervisors Susan Hawley and Jim Tilkens, Linda Frank, treasurer and Mary Lee Heise, clerk. Townspeople present were Mike and Sharon Steckbauer.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given by all those present.

The agenda was approved upon motion by Supervisor Hawley and seconded by Supervisor Tilkens, motion carried.

Minutes of the August meeting were approved upon motion by Supervisor Hawley and seconded by Supervisor Tilkens, motion carried.

The treasurer's report was given by Linda Frank. Reassessment CD has come due. That amount of money will be put in checking to pay any upcoming bill for the reassessment. The motion to pull the reassessment cd 1 money and transfer it to the checking account was made by Supervisor Hawley and seconded by Supervisor Tilkens, motion carried. Thereafter the report was approved upon motion by Supervisor Hawley and seconded by Supervisor Tilkens, motion carried.

Recognition of non-board members and non-board member business:

Unfinished Business: Hollister Bridge project emails from Jim Borysenko to DNR Jon Simonson re postponement of bridge project. We will have until the 15th to finish this project. We just have to wait till the weather cooperates. Signs will be posted as soon as we can begin. Telephone line discussed. Problems with having Frontier marking the area were also discussed. There are three different lines that will have to be taken care of prior to the project starting.

New Business: Towns Association Meeting on September 17, 2014. The meeting will be here. The "Scenic Byway" on Highway 55 will be discussed at this meeting.

General Building and Plant:

Highway – East Hollister Road and other roadwork. Mowing is done now that the motor on the mower was replaced. No paving will be done this year. Highway Aids for this year were discussed. We have to pay the entire bill to Duffek Sand and Gravel. We will then request reimbursement for one half of the Duffek bill from the County. The money from the reimbursement will go into savings to be used next year.

Fire Department: The 2% Fire Aids will be turned over to the department.

Rescue Squad: There were 9 calls last month compared to 26 the month before. A poster for the rescue squad will be posted in the town's bulletin board.

Recycling/Disposal Center everything is fine. Larry shot a bear and so Jeff Steinbach filled in for Larry on Saturday.

Cemetery – Everything is quiet. Many compliments on how nice the cemetery looks.

Correspondence: Note from Servco FS thanking us for our business. DOT – Mileage Maps to Review by 12/15 Wisconsin Dept. of Revenue-Shared Revenue we will receive in November. Bridge Inspection Reports for Van Alstine and the bridge on Town Line Road. Minor Subdivision applications from the County for West Hollister Road. Langlade County Humane Society – requesting donation. This matter was tabled. Cemetery Deed was presented to be signed and given back to Mike Klimoski. Check from the Wisconsin Municipal Clerks Association with a check for \$250 which is the scholarship the clerk received at the 2013 Clerk's conference that will be applied towards the amount the town spent for this year's conference. Sheets from the county zoning office with permits that were issued. A Building Compliance Statement for Silver Birch Ranch was received. The clerk is wondering what the town should do with this. New fire number for Connors Drive by Ada Lake was received. A new sign will be ordered.

Bills: Bills for September were approved upon motion by Supervisor Hawley and seconded by Supervisor Tilkens, motion carried.
