**Public Comments** (Limit of 2 Minutes): Persons attending the meeting may provide input on any village matter. This is the only time the public will be allowed to speak unless specifically on the agenda.

- Judy Popelka stated she was disappointed by the shortened fireworks. Joe G. explained that now that we have our own pontoons we can bid out to other vendors.
- Dave Peterson stated that there was not any sawdust pile at the celebration for the kids. Joe G. explained it was overlooked and not ordered in enough time. Dave also stated the fireworks were short. He suggested the parade committee should designate one "go to" person so individuals have a contact person for questions. Also stated that he felt the night band was too loud.
- Sally Mullhollon stated that maybe a dance could be held as a fundraiser for fireworks donations. Patsy suggested a possible raffle to get people to donate. Sally also asked if something could be done with the stop sign at the corner of the mill and Lake Street. She has witnessed people not stopping. Joe G. will make a call to Langlade County Sheriff to see if they will patrol the area.
- Judy Peterson stated that she only seen Joe Grennell and Doug Halverson from the parade committee during the time she was at the celebration. She wondered if other committee members helped. Judy also stated that a new Music at the Depot was added on Tuesday, July 23. They will also have pie and ice cream.

**Unfinished Business**

**Trustee Reports:**

- Permits-Only permit unapproved yet is Heistad property. More research is being done before a decision can be made.
- Fire Dept.-Nothing to report. Just regular monthly meeting held
- Troutland-They have a new EMT. They are speeding up their training. WPS is working on refresher training on gas leaks and down power lines with them also. 58 calls YTD compared to 74 at this time last year.
- Neighborhood Watch-No meeting held. Patsy thanked Mulhollon's for helping Harold Brennan with yard work.

**New Business**

- ATV Discussion-Elmer Mulhollon from the ATV Club is asking the village to consider opening up the area from Marathon Drive to Lakeside Drive as an ATV route. Joe G. asked Elmer to present, to the village board, a written plan and map out the current trails and also show where they are asking for new trails. Discussion took place on pros and cons and different options. Potential of opening it up could bring more business to local establishments and made traveling from one point to another on the ATV's much easier access, but the concern was the danger of having ATV's traveling on a curvy road that is used by vehicles, walkers and bikes.
- Announce new part time Public Works employee as Brad Johnson from Antigo. He will be working 3 days a week.

#### Projects

- Community Center siding project is complete. Just painting needs to be done on the backside of the building.

#### Clerk's Report

- Stated that Scott turned in a couple set of keys and a wallet that were found at the pavilion after the celebration. Carol will follow up on trying to find the owners.
- Carol also reported that she was awarded a scholarship to attend the conference in August in Milwaukee.

#### Public Works Report

- No problems with the bathrooms the past couple weeks at the pavilion. They have been unlocked and all has been good.
- Scott is working on his project list now that the celebration is over and Brad is here.
- Possible leak in the water system. He is working on trying to find it.
- Ballpark power is in.
- Still issues with dogs at the beach/pavilion area-Joe G. suggested we send letters to village residents which includes the ordinance on no dogs at the beach.
