Approve Agenda-Motion by Patsy Listle/Mary Lou Pomasl, All Ayes.

Public Comments (Limit of 2 Minutes): Persons attending the meeting may provide input on any village matter. This is the only time the public will be allowed to speak unless specifically on the agenda.

- Dave Peterson commented on the ATV route between Gamble and S. Shore Street is incorrect in their direction description. He also asked if school buses or ambulances used Marathon Drive. He also stated that there are several dangerous curves on the road and hopes the board takes that into consideration.

Unfinished Business

- ATV route on Marathon Drive-Discussion between trustees held. Mary Lou stated she considered both sides and with a 25 mph speed limit for vehicles and 10 mph for ATVs it should be safe if obeyed. Joe Grennell stated the ordinance states that residents are already given access from their homes to the trail. Safety concerns with the curves in that area. Patsy Listle stated that people need to be aware and responsible for the speed limits and safety on that roadway. Cheri Hoffman stated she received several comments from both White Lake residents and non residents who belong to the ATV club and they all stated they did not feel it was a safe route. Poor visibility due to the curving of the road was a major concern Cheri heard. Cheri stated the current route does not seem to be hurting the businesses. Cheri stated safety needs to be priority, she agreed that people should follow speed limits and take responsibility but this is not always the case. Cheri stated people familiar with Marathon Dr. may be more cautious, but the route extends to all those on ATV's and all are not familiar. Cheri also stated that nothing different was presented since the last time it was reviewed and felt that the board should consider and respect the previous board decision. Cheri also stated that the previous board had public hearings and discussion on this route and it was voted down. Motion made by Cheri Hoffman/Patsy Listle to Make no changes to the current ATV route and close the Marathon Drive discussion. The board would be open to hear alternate routes suggested by the club. All Ayes.

Trustee Reports:

- Permits- Cheri Hoffman reported-Clayton- will be submitting for a permit to pour concrete and finish driveway, Heistad-waiting on Heistad to receive quotes on water sewer hookup, Schell-Creating a new primary driveway entrance and eliminating existing driveway
- FireDept.-Patsy Listle reported-\$10,000 will be taken from the FD checking and put in a 12 month CD, working on hydrant issue, auxiliary did a cardiac rehab class and usual checks on equipment.
- Troutland-Mary Lou Pomasl reported- Troutland will ask for board approval in October for an increase for the Troutland President's pay, there has been no increase for 2 years, many added responsibilities now have been added to presidents duties, asking for \$13.50 x 22 hours weekly for 2014.
- Neighborhood Watch-Patsy Listle reported-Patsy is an official member of Langlade County Crime Stoppers. She explained to call Crime Stoppers if you have detail of a crime committed and it leads to an arrest, you will receive reward money.

New Business

- Antigo House Authority-Request for Bid on plowing at Church St Apts.-Discussion held. Scott will put together a letter to send to housing authority with a quote on salting and sanding only.

Projects- Cheri Hoffman reported:

- Placement of the sign at the boar landing will most likely take place next year.
- New sidewalk construction to begin this week. G&B Concrete will work with postal contractor to comply with ADA regulations required for the post office.
- Community center project is finishing up with the final completion of trim painting and new village of White Lake letters to hang on the building.

Public Works Report- Scott Popelka reported:

- Scott thanked the board for allowing him and James to attend the WRWA Outdoor Expo.
- Eric from Rural Water came out to help Scott pinpoint the leak.
- Historical Society will get hooked up with water/sewer next week.
- Took public bulletin board down to prepare for sidewalk concrete work.
- Took flags down in Village. They are to be up from Memorial Day until just after the 4th celebration starting next year. Legion will replace any worn flags. Scott thought about 26 could be replaced out of 50.
